

Alleged Corrupt Activities of DepEd Local Officials

- The Office of the Secretary has received reports alleging that several Division Superintendents (SDO) and other DepEd Local Officials in certain areas have been soliciting money and gifts from newly-hired teachers in exchange for their hiring and other corrupt activities.
- 2. In view of this, to prevent possible occurrence of such anomalous activities the following are suggested:
  - 2.1 All PSB members should be prohibited from dealing with teacherapplicants
  - 2.2 All queries regarding their rank, possible hiring and appointment shall be referred to the Schools Division Superintendent.
  - 2.3 Teacher-applicants be given orientation on hiring and appointment.
  - 2.4 Posting on web-site "leacher Items NOT FOR SALE,"
  - 2.5 Documents of the teacher-appointee should be coursed to the Schools Admin Office by the authorized Liaison Officer of School or district.
- Any report regarding anomalous activities should be promptly addressed and recommend appropriate action against any school personnel found involved in any corrupt practice.
