# CONDUCT OF THE 2020 NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY/WORLD TEACHERS CELEBRATIONS AND GUIDELINES ON THE VIRTUAL CONDUCT OF TEACHERS' GOT TALENT

- 1. The Republic Act No. 10743 and UNESCO have designated October 5 of every year as National Teachers' Day (NTD) and World Teachers' Day (WTD), a day to honor teachers and the central role they play in guiding children, youth and adults through the life-long learning process. In the Philippines, we have made it a month-long celebration by observing National Teachers' Month (NTM) which starts on September 5 and ends on October 5. Schools, companies, government agencies, local government units, private groups and individuals have been participating in the NTM through various ways of honoring teachers. This year's theme is **"Gurong Filipino para sa Batang Filipino."**
- 2. All School heads are enjoined to actively lead the virtual activities for the NTM, NTD and WTD celebrations.
- 3. To further promote the celebrations, your good offices are encouraged to print event materials and have it displayed at your schools. #### CONTEST GUIDELINES ON TEACHERS' GOT TALENT

- 4.1 The participants are reminded to observe and follow minimum health standards such as wearing of facemasks/shields, regular washing of hands, using disinfectants like alcohol and sanitizers, and observing social distancing, consistent with the guidelines from Inter Agency Task Force (AITF), Department of Health (DOH), and the Department of Education (DepEd) and local government units (LGUs).
- 4.2 The contest is open to public school teachers, any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting, etc.
- 4.3 Only one contestant or group per school shall be allowed to join. If joining as a group, a maximum of ten (10) members shall be allowed.
- 4.4 Each interested individual or group shall sign the application letter form. The performance will be pre-recorded and the videographer can utilize different angles using mobile phone, digital camera, among other means. The presentation should last for a maximum of seven (7) minutes only. Two (2) points will automatically be deducted for excess minute/s.
- 4.5 Once the video recording is available, contestants shall send the video and application form (Enclosure 1) via email to <a href="leoval.delacruz@deped.gov.ph">leoval.delacruz@deped.gov.ph</a> with the subject 2020TGT\_(Region)\_(Name of Contestant/Group's Name).
- 4.6 All entries should be submitted not later than September 26, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.
- 4.7 Only one contestant will be chosen to represent our division in the National Level.
- 4.8 The criteria for judging are as follows:
  - a. Talent, Interpretation and Skill 50%
  - b. Originality and Creativity 25%
  - c. Projection and Overall Impact 25%
- 4.9 National Winners of this year's TGT competition may either get cash prizes or gadgets.




