IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL BASED FEEDING PROGRAM- MILK FEEDING COMPONENT IN THE NEW NORMAL

1. Pursuant to Republic Act 11037 also known as **Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act**, promulgated on June 20, 2018, the National Feeding Program shall be implemented targeting all undernourished in Public Day Care, Kindergarten and Elementary Schools to address hunger, poor nutritional status and increase number of Public School enrollee. One of the components of the National Feeding Program is the Milk Feeding Program.
2. In connection with this and in light of COVID-19 Pandemic and continuous increase in the number of cases in the community, the Milk Feeding Program in the Division of Science City of Munoz shall be implemented in accordance with DepEd Order no. 36, s.2019 or the Guidelines on the Implementation of School Based Feeding Program – Milk Feeding Program Component, DepEd Order No. 22 s.2020 or Additional Provisions and Amendments to DepEd Order No.36 s.2020 and DepEd Order No. 14 s. 2020 entitled Guidelines on the Health Standards and Protocols in Basic DepEd Offices and Schools in order to ensure the health, safety and well-being of learners, parents, stakeholders and DepEd personnel in all Public Elementary Schools during the time of implementation in order to attain its primary objective despite the many challenges encountered this schoolyear.
3. The School Based Feeding Program – Milk Feeding Component for SY 2019-2020 shall now commence in November 9, 2020 which will be conducted for a period of 20 days. The beneficiaries for the SBFP-Milk Feeding Component will still be the same learners identified to be the recipients for SBFP- hot meals for School Year 2019-2020.

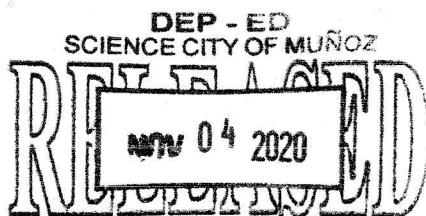



4. In line with this the Division of Science City of Munoz entered a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Carabao Center as our Partner agency for the procurement of pasteurized Carabao's milk. On the other hand, PCC tap the Catalanacan Multipurpose Cooperative (CAMPC) for the production and delivery of pasteurized Carabao's milk to two designated drop off points namely Munoz Central Elementary School and Linlingay Elementary School with a twice a week schedule of delivery every Mondays and Wednesdays as agreed upon during the SBFP Division Orientation and SBFP Special Meeting respectively.
5. A service delivery fee shall be downloaded from the SDO to the 2 designated drop off points to ensure on time delivery and distribution of the pasteurized milk to all Public Elementary schools for inspection. The school Inspection Team shall sign the Delivery Receipt (DR) and the Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR) every delivery. Parents are tasked to pick up the milk on designated days and time.
6. Public health standards to prevent spread and mitigate COVID-19 should be strictly followed.
7. Moreover, all schools shall document the receipt of milk supply by parents for all deliveries made. All receiving documents shall be forwarded to SDO at the end of feeding cycle for accounting and recording purposes.
