# REITERATION OF MONTHLY SUBMISSION OF NATIONAL DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

- 1. The National Drug Education Program is one of the six flagship programs under the Oplan Kalusugan Ok sa DepEd Program through the Bureau of Learner Support Services of the Department of Education. As being stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No.200 s.2016 entitled Strengthening the National Drug Education Program in Schools, NDEP is a comprehensive educational program that provides for a holistic approach to the problem of drug abuse. It was designed to enable all sectors to work collaboratively with the school system as the core, thereby unifying all sectoral endeavors.
- 2. The program has five components namely: (a.) Curriculum and Instruction; (b.) Co- Curricular and Ancillary Services; (c) Teacher and Staff Development; (d) Parent Education and Community Outreach and (e) Research, Monitoring and Evaluation. It is implemented in the schools to create awareness on the illeffects of abusing drugs and to develop among learners a positive behavior and life skills to resist drugs.
- 3. In line with this, all Public Elementary and Secondary Schools in the Division of Science City of Munoz are hereby instructed to conduct virtual activities using different social media platforms, provide IEC materials about the ill-effects of Drug Abuse and integrate these topics in the Self Learning Modules.


