CONDUCT OF SCHOOL BASED FEEDING PROGRAM-MILK FEEDING COMPONENT FOR SY 2020-2021

- To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief ES SGOD Medical Officer III Division SBFP Focal Person School Heads of Public Elementary Schools School SBFP-Milk Coordinators All Other Concerned
- 1. The School Based Feeding Program- Milk Feeding Component for the SY 2020-2021 shall now commence on March 29,2021 which will be conducted for a period of 25 days. The beneficiaries for this program will still be the same identified learners and or recipients of SBFP- Nutritious Food Packs for the School Year 2020-2021 with a total number of 2960 learners from Kindergarten to Grade VI Level.
- 2. The objective of this program is to address hunger, poor nutritional status and increase the number of Public School enrollee in all Public Elementary Schools in the Division of Science City of Munoz in accordance with DepEd Order No.36, s.2019 entitled the Guidelines on the Implementation of School Based Feeding Program- Milk Feeding Program Component, DepEd Order No.22, s. 2020 or Additional Provisions and Amendments to DepEd Order No.36, 2020 and DepEd Order No.14 s,2020 or Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic DepEd Offices and Schools in order to ensure the health, safety and well-being of learners, parents, stakeholders and DepEd personnel during program implementation in the time of COVID-19 Pandemic.
- 3. Once again, the Division of Science City of Munoz entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Carabao Center as our Partner Agency for the procurement, production and delivery of pasteurized Carabao's milk with two


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designated drop off points namely Munoz Central School and Linglingay Elementary School and with a twice a week schedule of delivery every Mondays and Wednesdays as agreed upon during the Conduct of Virtual Special Meeting on Oplan Kalusugan Ok sa DepEd Program held last February 16,2021.

- 4. The School Inspection Team shall sign the Delivery Receipt (DR) and the Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR) every delivery. Parents are tasked to pick up the milk on designated days and time in compliance with the minimum health standards and protocols promulgated by the IATF for COVD-19. All schools shall document the receipt of milk supply by parents for all deliveries made. All receiving documents shall be forwarded to SDO at the end of feeding cycle for accounting and recording purposes.
