## SEARCH FOR HERITAGE TREES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All YES-O Advisers

- 1. Pursuant to OUA Memo 00-0521-0133 dated April 26, 2021, the Schools Division Office through the Youth Formation Coordinator announces the **Search for Heritage Trees in Public Schools** as part of the International Day for Biological Diversity with the theme *We're part of the solution #ForNature*.
- 2. All eligible school heads, teaching and non-teaching personnel may participate in this activity. The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) will select the top 10 winners to receive a pair of shoes, laptop bag and flash drive.
- 3. The following are the requirements in submitting entries:
  - a. Selfie with the heritage tree (heritage refers to any healthy native, endemic, exotic, rare, threatened, and endangered tree with a minimum girth of five (5) meters;
  - b. Picture of the tree itself;
  - c. Certificate for the age of the tree from the local Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR); and
  - d. Brief history of the tree (maximum of one page)
- 4. Entries must be submitted until **07 June 2021** via jonnadel.patonona@deped.gov.ph for consolidation and submission to the Central Office.
