To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Film Development Council of the Philippines, in partnership with the Department of Education, announces its short film competition on "Lesser-known Filipino Heroes, Unsung Sariling Bayani", as this year's theme.
- 2. The activity highlights "Unsung Sariling Bayani" and intends to strike a balance on the influence of foreign superheroes from Marvel and DC among Filipino Youths of today.
- 3. The competition is open to all Filipinos under the following categories:
 - 3.1 Youth Category for Junior to Senior High School for Public School;

The Film Development Council of the Philippines, the national agency responsible for film policies and programs to ensure the economics, cultural and educational development of the Philippine Film Industry, will conduct a short film competition focused on the theme of lesser-known Filipino heroes, "Unsung Sariling Bayani." National Artist for Film and Broadcast, Kidlat Tahimik is the leading proponent of this cinematic movement for the youth, aiming to balance the influence of foreign superheroes from Marvel and DC in the Filipino youth's mindset with a compelling engagement with the glorious stories of our very own heroes.

The competition is open to all Filipinos with the following categories:

- a. Youth Category for Junior to Senior High School Student from Public School;
- b. Youth Category for Junior to Senior High School Student from Private School; and
- c. Adult Category, ages 18 and above.

With the persistent public demand, we are now expanding the categories to Junior High School in both youth categories for public and private to allow for more of the youth to participate in the program.

There will be two (2) shortlisted entries each per region from public and private schools which are to be submitted to the FDCP for evaluation and judging. From the shortlisted entries submitted by the regions, the FDCP Selection Committee will choose:

Ten (10) entries from **Public** School Students Category (Junior-Senior High School):

- Two (2) from NCR
- Two (2) from Luzon

- Two (2) from the Visayas
- Two (2) from Mindanao
- Two (2) from BARMM

Ten (10) entries from Private School Students Category (Junior-Senior High School):

- Two (2) from NCR
- Two (2) from Luzon
- Two (2) from the Visayas
- Two (2) from Mindanao
- Two (2) from BARMM

Each DepEd Region Office may designate two (2) judges who will evaluate the films together with a filmmaker appointed by the FDCP.

All entries will be evaluated with the following criteria:

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING		
CREATIVITY AND STYLE	Impactful composition of visuals and sound that effectively communicate the film's story and objectives.	35%
RELEVANCE TO THE THEME	Promotes deeper familiarity and love for our own heroes, their lives, and achievements for our country.	45%
PRODUCTION QUALITY	Good, practical filmmaking with technical efficiency and cohesiveness.	20%
TOTAL		100%

Additionally, National Artist Kidlat Tahimik will also conduct an online session with *Special Program in the Arts* (SPA) teachers, Senior High School Arts and Design Track teachers, and those who will be coaching students who will join the competition. The session aims to orient teachers about the intent of the project and how they can be instrumental in reintroducing our unsung local heroes to the youth.
