- The Schools Division Office through the School Governance and Operations Division-Youth Formation, provides the following guidelines to Division Memorandum No. 399 titled Conduct of Youth Formation Organizations Elections for School Year 2021-2022 under the New Normal as follows:
 - Qualified candidates for elective positions: a.
 - 1.1.1 All elected class vice presidents of all homeroom class organizations are qualified to run for YES-O and BKD elections. This is to give them a chance to hone their leadership skills;
 - Elected presidents of homeroom class organizations may choose to run for an elective position to only one of the youth formation organizations (SPG/SSG/YES-O/BKD).
- All other provisions stipulated in Division Memorandum No. 399 shall remain 2. the same.


