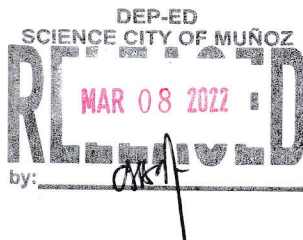

I. REFERENCE:

➤ Memorandum from FIRE DIRECTOR LEONARD R BAÑAGO, Chief, BFP-NHQ dated 08 January 2019 re: Mechanics of Games and Contests For CY 2019 Observance of Fire Prevention Month.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT

With the need to undertake continuous and sustained efforts through minimum financial requirements in the formulation of fire prevention awareness campaign through the conduct of various games and contests relevant to BFP's advocacy in ensuring a fire safe nation during the month-long observance of **Fire Prevention Month 2022**
Theme: "Sa Pag-iwas sa Sunog, Hindi ka Nag-iisa".

In order to provide standard procedures and rules to be observed by the concerned units and offices in facilitating the conduct of games and contest on different categories to be implemented nationwide, this mechanics is hereby promulgated.

III. SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY

This mechanics shall cover the following games and contests, to wit:

- A. **Drawing Contest** – For Elementary Students (Grades 1 to 6);
- B. **Poster Making Contest** - For Junior and Senior High School Students (Grades 7 to 12)

IV. OBJECTIVES

- A. To establish clear categorical rules, criteria and procedures on the conduct of Fire Prevention Month CY 2022 games and art contests; and

V. MECHANICS

A. STATION LEVEL

1. The Fire Station shall ensure that all above said Fire Prevention Month CY 2022 art contest are undertaken by all cities/municipalities within their area of responsibility. For this purpose, the Provincial Fire Marshal thru the City/Municipal Fire Marshals, shall coordinate with their Local Chief Executives (LCE), in seeking the assistance of school officials in facilitating and encouraging the participation of interested pupils/students

2. Entries shall strictly observe the following set of mechanics and criteria for judging:

a.) Drawing Contest – For Elementary Pupils (Grades 1 to 6);

Mechanics:

- Must be drawn/illustrated in ½ size (20 x 30 inches) illustration board (PORTRAIT LAYOUT shall be strictly observed, otherwise the entry will be disqualified) using either crayons or oil pastel to be provided by the BFP;
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title and brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size for exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said drawing/illustration; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and unappeasable.

Criteria for Judging	Rating
Theme Relevance Does the drawing/illustration effectively communicate the Fire Prevention Month CY 2022 theme?	40%
Creativity and Originality Does the drawing/illustration demonstrate creativity and originality?	30%
Aesthetic Appeal Does the drawing/illustration captivate the judge's sense, taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?	30%
Over-all Impression	100%

b.) Poster Making Contest – For Junior and Senior High School Students (Grades 7 to 12)

Mechanics:

- Must be drawn/illustrated in ½ size (20 x 30 inches) illustration board (**PORTRAIT LAYOUT** shall be strictly observed, otherwise the entry will be disqualified) using water color to be provided by the BFP:
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title and brief description of the poster which shall be attached at the back of their entry. Likewise, all participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size for exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said posters; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and unappeasable.

Criteria for Judging	Rating
Theme Relevance Does the poster effectively communicate the Fire Prevention Month CY 2022 theme?	40%
Creativity and Originality Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality?	30%
Aesthetic Appeal Does the poster design captivate the judge's sense, taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?	30%
Over-all Impression	100%

VI. WINNERS/PRIZES

A. STATION LEVEL

1. Prizes for each category (Poster Making and Drawing Contest) shall be:

1st Prize	-	3,000.00
2nd Prize	-	2,000.00
3rd Prize	-	1,000.00

2. During the Culminating Ceremony, prizes and awards for the winning entries on the said contest shall be received by the authorized representatives.

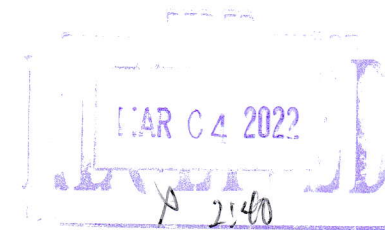
