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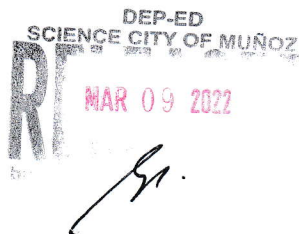

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2. The Committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:
 - a. Evaluate and deliberate the qualifications of those listed in the selection line up;
 - b. Make a systematic assessment of the qualification and competence of candidates for reclassification;
 - c. Conduct an onsite validation of documents and actual performance of applicants;
 - d. Address any issues and concerns if there is any within a duration of 3 days; and
 - e. Submit to the appointing authority the short list of the ranking candidates whenever possible, where over-all points are comparatively at par at each other based in the comparative assessment conducted.
