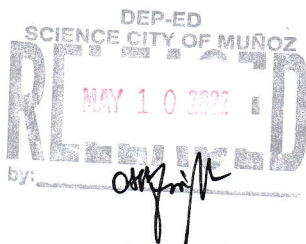

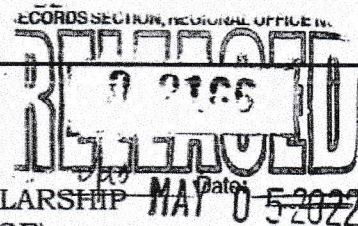

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

I. PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

For the purpose of addressing the demand for the Chinese language speakers in different industries in the Philippines, the Fujian Normal University and Fujian Provincial Education Department established a Bachelor's Degree major in Chinese language and minor in business, tourism, and other technical-vocational courses. This supports the implementation of the Special Program in Foreign Language-Chinese Mandarin (SPFL-CM) of the Department of Education of the Philippines by providing students with opportunity to continue their Chinese studies in the tertiary level.

The degree is designed to equip Filipino students with wide range of linguistic and theoretical knowledge and skills that will allow them more options and greater flexibility in working to different industries. The design features include various components that correspond to the basic and specialized knowledge and skills that will be needed by a practicing bilingual professional including Chinese language knowledge and skills, theoretical knowledge about intercultural communication, and specialized knowledge appropriate to the chosen industry.

II. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Bachelor in Chinese language+ is a four-year program which aims to develop competent and effective Chinese language speakers in different industries. This program is design to develop student's communicative competence for specific discipline including tourism, business, information technology, and teaching.

III. ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant shall be:

- ❖ Non-Chinese citizen;
- ❖ Legal age Filipino citizen;
- ❖ No criminal record or pending criminal case;
- ❖ Abiding the laws and regulations of the University and of the Chinese government;
- ❖ In good physical and mental conditions;
- ❖ Graduate of SPFL-Chinese Mandarin program with outstanding academic records;
- ❖ Recommended by the SPFL-Chinese Mandarin implementing school;

IV. SCHOLARSHIP COVERAGE

The program commences in August 2022. The study plan covers a maximum of four academic years in FNU. The scholarship program shall provide the following:

- ❖ tuition fees
- ❖ accommodation fees*
- ❖ monthly living allowance*
- ❖ comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China*

**This only applies upon arrival in China and does not apply during the temporary remote/online learning mode (See Mode of Delivery).*

V. MODE OF DELIVERY

The program commences in September 2022. In case the travel restrictions would not permit students to go to China, remote online learning will be adapted as mode of delivery. Face-to-face delivery of instruction will depend on the pandemic situation in both countries.

VI. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Step 1: DepEd Central Office will release Memorandum informing the SPFL-Chinese Mandarin Schools of the scholarship program.

Step 2: Each DepEd region will send its recommended students to DepEd Central Office.

Step 3: DepEd-Central Office will forward the list of recommended students to CI-AUF.

Step 4: FNU will screen the applicants and qualified students will be asked to submit their documentary requirements.

Step 5: Qualified applicants register and enroll in FNU.

VII. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

List of documentary requirements for admission will be sent to the qualified students via email.
