The Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) shall release the revised Special Program for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (SPSTEM) curriculum to address the curricular and policy concerns specific to the Special Science Elementary Schools, Special Curricular Program for Science, Technology, and Engineering, Regional Science High School, and Legislated Science High School.
- 2. Relative to this, the BCD will conduct a Consultative Forum Workshop on the Revision of the Special Program for STEM Curriculum on **May 3 to 5, 2023**, to be attended by SPSTEM implementers and STEM Regional Focal Persons.
- 3. The workshop aims to:
  - a. review the current draft special program curriculum and identify areas that require improvement or modification;
  - gather feedback and input from various stakeholders, including teachers, students, parents, and education experts on the proposed changes to the said curriculum;
  - c. draft the proposal for a revised curriculum that is aligned with the needs and interests of the learners and promotes the development of critical thinking, problem-solving, and other key skills that are essential for success in the 21st-century; and
  - d. ensure that the revised special program curriculum aligns with the broader goals and objectives of the K to 12 Basic Education System.
- 4. All Division Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) in Science shall track the completion of the said survey and provide technical assistance to the queries of the implementing schools when necessary.
