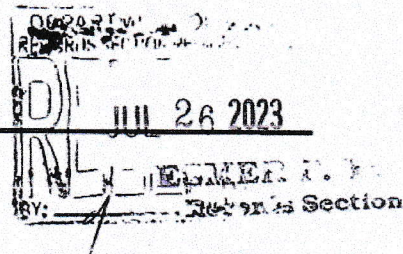

The Department of Education through the Bureau of Learning Resources - Quality Assurance Division (BLR-QAD) conducted a virtual workshop on the *Evaluation of Learning Resources for the National Learning Camp* on June 26 to 28, 2023. This activity evaluated learning resources (LRs) that will be used during the National Learning Camp (NLC) starting on July 24, 2023.

Please be reminded that the materials may only be shared with trainers, learning resource supervisors, reproduction teams, participating teachers, and concerned personnel from School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) and Curriculum Implementation Division (CID). Unauthorized sharing is strictly prohibited.

In this connection, we are reiterating strict observance of the Republic Act 8293, section 176 or the "Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines" on the evaluated learning resources. It states that *"no copyright shall subsist in any work of the Government of the Philippines. However, prior approval of the government agency or office wherein the work is created shall be necessary for exploitation of such work for profit. Such agency or office may, among other things, impose as a condition the payment of royalties."*
