

In this connection, we are reiterating strict observance of the Republic Act 8293, section 176 or the "Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines" on the evaluated learning resources. It states that "no copyright shall subsist in any work of the Government of the Philippines. However, prior approval of the government agency or office wherein the work is created shall be necessary for exploitation of such work for profit. Such agency or office may, among other things, impose as a condition the payment of royalties."
