e. The school with the highest garnered score shall be declared as Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan (EGPP)-Project GAME Division Winner in each category.

6. Schools Division Winners for the Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementers in Elementary and Secondary will participate in the Regional Search on November 20 to December 1, 2023. Regional Winners shall receive a cash prize, plaque, and certificate of recognition.

- 2. Best EGPP-Project GAME School Implementer in Secondary

c. Each SDO shall submit one (1) entry per category using the attached template on or before November 15, 2023 through this link: https://tinyurl.com/2023EGPPofficialentry. Late submission of list of entries shall not be accepted.

d. Means of verification (MOVs) as indicated in the criteria must be presented during the onsite validation to the Regional Search Committee, otherwise no points shall be given. The criteria for Search are attached in this Memorandum.

e. During the onsite validation, school is requested to prepare and present the 2022 Gulayan sa Paraalan Program accomplishment report to the RSC.

f. School with highest garnered scores shall be declared as Best Enhanced Gulayan sa Paaralan (EGPP)-Project GAME Regional Winner in each category.
