 - b. gain knowledge of basic expressive and receptive communicative competency in Filipino sign language;
 - c. sign vocabularies and sentences used in learning areas, like English, Science, Mathematics, Araling Panlipunan and Filipino using the principles and proper guidelines on signing effectively; and
 - d. sign songs/poems/ skits for young children and adults.
3. Participants in this activity are the 16 pre-registered elementary, junior and senior high school SPED receiving teachers (see enclosure No.1 for the list of participants).
4. To ensure that no classes will be affected and continuous quality education is practiced, modular instructions and other alternative delivery modes will be provided to the learner by the SPED/receiving teachers who will attend the training.
5. This Memorandum shall serve as the Authority to Travel of the Participants.
6. The board and lodging of the participants shall be charged against downloaded funds from the DepEd Central Office while their travel expenses shall be charged against the School MOOE/local funds subject to the usual government auditing rules and regulations.

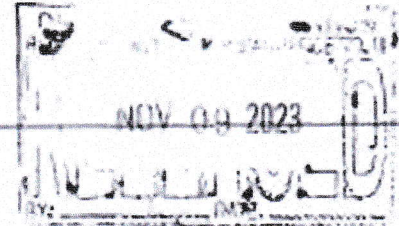



In line with the Department's strong commitments articulated in **Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP) 2030** on addressing learning loss along the pillars of access, equity, equality, well-being and resilience, and the **MATATAG Agenda: *Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa*** on **TA**ke good care of learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education and a positive learning environment and **GI**ve support to teachers to teach better, the Department of Education Regional Office 3, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct Regional Training in Level 1 and Level 2 Filipino Sign Language (FSL) from **November 14-17, 2023**, at **Hacienda Gracia Resort and Hotel, Lubao, Pampanga**.
2. This activity aims to enable the participants to:
 - a. demonstrate competence in receptive and expressive visual readiness for acquiring basic Filipino sign language skills;

4. The check-in time of participants will be on November 13, 2023, with dinner as the first provision of the meal, and the last meal will be the p.m. snack on November 17, 2023.
5. To ensure that no classes will be affected, and continuous quality education is practiced, modular instructions and other alternative delivery modes will be



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provided to the learners handled by the SPED/receiving teachers who attend the training.
