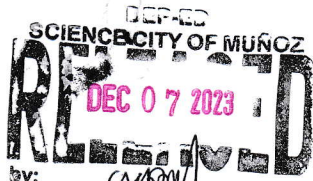


1. Relative to the DepEd Memorandum No. 050, s. 2023 titled **2023 Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars for The Philippine High School for The Arts**, this Office announces that the PHSA Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS) is now accepting applications for Full Special Secondary (K-12) Scholarship for School Year 2023-2024. Application is open to all currently enrolled Grade 6 pupils from both public and private schools.
2. This program aims to identify and develop artistically gifted and talented children to become artists of excellence in the field of dance, music, theater, creative writing, and visual arts.
3. In this regard, our schools division has a pool of talented individuals who can benefit greatly from this opportunity. Therefore, all public elementary secondary schools are requested to provide assistance in the following ways:
 - a. Disseminate information about the auditions to eligible students, providing details about the criteria for selection, audition date, and venue.
 - b. Identify and recommend applicants who meet the criteria for the auditions;
 - c. Encourage eligible students to participate in the audition process,
 - d. Submit a list of recommended applicants by school along with the scanned copies of their application forms. A Google link will be provided for your convenience, and
 - e. Inform the applicants to bring the original copy of the Application Form on the day of the audition.
4. In preparation for the upcoming auditions for the Philippine High School of the Arts (PHSA), a visit to the selected schools—Munoz Central School, Munoz North Central School, and Brilliant Kids Montessori School has been scheduled on December 11, 2023.
5. The ANSYAS Team will conduct the Audition and Examination in City Tourism Office on December 12, 2023.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Overview

The School
The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) is a government-run secondary school for artistically talented students. It implements a special secondary education curriculum aimed at training and honing future artists and cultural leaders. Aside from academic and artistic training, PHSA provides students with opportunities to develop their social skills, contributing to their development as artists for others.

Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS)

The Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS) is the yearly screening of incoming Grade 7 applicants to the Philippine High School for the Arts to identify and award scholarships to promising students from all over the country. The primary objective of the search is to identify and award the selection of addition candidates to determine their skills and talent, as well as their scholastic standing.

Curriculum

The Basic Education subjects prescribed by the Department of Education are in the PHSA K-12 curriculum. These subjects are handled descriptively in support of specialized studies for artistic expressions in the following disciplines:

- Creative Writing:** Fables, Poetry, Playwriting, Creative Narration, Graphic Literature
- Dance (Ballet, Folk Dance):** Fundamental dance steps and rhythm, dance notation and interpretation, choreography and composition, modern and contemporary dance, dance production and research, Prilipagang-arte and restaurantation, basic production design and production management and instrumentation, basic production design and production management
- Music:** applied music (voice/instrument), music theory, chorus, chamber music, music literature, large ensemble (jazz), foreign language, technical theater, acting, directing, stage ensemble building, theater theories, technical theater, stage and production management
- Visual Arts:** Visual Perception, Art Appreciation, Studio Painting, Materials and Techniques, Film Cinematography

Scholarship Privileges

- Free tuition
- Board and lodging (except during weekends)
- Concessions with master teachers
- Free medical services
- Free meals
- The chance to represent the country and the school in international tests, competitions, and exchange programs
- The scholarship grant is renewable every year for six (6) consecutive school years upon satisfaction of academic and non-academic requirements

Scholarship Eligibility

- To be eligible for scholarship, an applicant must:
 - be a Filipino citizen with no pending application as applicant to any foreign country;
 - be a high school graduate at the time of application
 - pass the audition and interview
 - be physically and mentally fit

 - SFA (Grade 6 report card/certificate Grade 6 report card)
 - one-page resume (CV) using recent photograph (attach photo)

Onsite / Face to Face: Audition Requirements

- BALLET**
 - Complete ballet outfit
 - Soft shoes and pointe shoes for girls who are en pointe
- CREATIVE WRITING**
 - Short bond paper and writing materials (pencil, ballpen)
- FOLK DANCE**
 - Prepared dance number. Other Genre (Rhapop, Modern, Ballet, etc.) also acceptable
 - Music stored in USB/Flash Drive, or Mobile phone for prepared dance
 - Proper outfit:
 - Girls: Knee length loose skirt and sleeveless blouse
 - Boys: Slim fit shirt or sanda and shorts or pants

MUSIC

- PERFORM THE FOLLOWING FROM MEMORY:
 - **FOR VOICE APPLICANTS:****
 - Perform one (1) song from the Italian Anthology Book 1.
 - Perform one (1) kundiman or Filipino classical piece (choose from Abelardo, Cuenco, Santiago, Celso, San Pedro).
 - OR**
 - Present a 15-20 minute concert program of your choice.

FOR INSTRUMENT APPLICANTS:

- Play five (5) major scales and their relative minor scales (natural, harmonic and melodic)
- Perform two (2) of your most recent etudes
- Present a 15-20 minute classical program of your choice, which may include one (1) Filipino piece.

THEATER ARTS

- 3 to 5-minute performance piece (ex. monologue, declamation, oration, dramatic delivery of a poem, etc.) in English
- 3 to 5-minute performance piece (ex. monologue, declamation, oration, dramatic delivery of a poem, etc.) in Filipino
- a song in English / Filipino / any vernacular language or dialect
- wear loose and comfortable clothing for session on movement exploration; extra t-shirt, if needed

VISUAL ARTS

- maximum of 10 works only (labeled as numbers '1' to '10')
- works in perforated (AEG) or PDF format
- upload files onto one folder in Google Drive. Email the link of your Google Drive folder to phsa.ansyas@gmail.com.
- Five (5) color papers, pencils (preferably 3B and 6B pencils), any coloring materials preferred by applicants (watercolor, colored pencils, pastels, collared pencils, crayons)
