
All Others Concerned

- 1. In line with the thrusts to promote responsible and free journalism and pursuant to the provision of section 2 of RA 7079, this Office announces the conduct of Division Schools Press Conference on January 29-30, 2024 at MNHS-Main (JHS).
- 2. Anchored on the theme, "From Campus Journalism to Real-world Journalism: Shaping Minds from Schools to Societies", this activity aims to:
 - a. hone learners' real world journalism skills,
 - b. demonstrate commitment in the advocacies of campus journalism and integrating them in related school community initiatives through various platforms,
 - c. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions,
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media,
 - e. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for learners interested in pursuing journalism as a career, and
 - f. select participants who will represent the schools division to the 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC).
- 3. The DSPC activities shall include the following:

a. Individual Contests

- i. News Writing
- ii. Feature Writing
- iii. Editorial Writing
- iv. Sports Writing
- v. Copyreading and Headline Writing
- vi. Science and Technology Writing
- vii. Photojournalism
- viii. Editorial Cartooning
- ix. Column Writing
 - b. Group Contests
- i. Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting (English and Filipino, elementary and secondary)







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- ii. Collaborative Desktop Publishing (English and Filipino, elementary and secondary)
- iii. Online Publishing (English and Filipino, secondary only)
- iv. TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting (English and Filipino, secondary only)

c. School Paper Contests (English and Filipino, elementary and secondary in PDF)

- i. News Section
- ii. Feature Section
- iii. Editorial Section
- iv. Science and Technology Section
- v. Sports Section
- vi. Layout and Page Design
- 4. A campus journalist both in elementary and secondary levels shall be allowed to participate in a maximum of two contest categories.
- 5. The top five (5) winners shall be declared in elementary and secondary for each individual category and medium and the top three (3) winners in group categories. However, only the top three (3) winners in individuual contests and the champion teams in group events shall advance to the 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference.
- 6. The top three (3) winners shall receive medals and certificates, while the fourth and fifth placers shall have certificates only.
- 7. In the event a contestant cannot make it to the RSPC due to unavoidable circumstances, the concerned school paper adviser/coach, and schoolhead shall inform in writing the SDC for Journalism so the management can make the necessary replacement.
- 8. Photojournalists shall bring a digital camera (point and shoot) with a maximum of 24.3 megapixels with fixed lenses. The contest facilitator will provide bond papers for participants to write their captions. The outputs will be collected and stored in a designated folder for the evaluator's review.
- 9. The Search for Most Outstanding School Paper Adviser (MOSPA) and Most Outstanding Campus Journalists (MOCJ) at both elementary and secondary levels will also be conducted. Interested participants in these categories shall submit their documents after the DSPC to ensure the inclusion of their achievements in this event. The deadline of submission is on February 5, 2024. Entries must be sent to Mrs. Aileen G. Mactal, EPS in English, Dr. Mary Queen P. Orpilla, EPS in Filipino and Ms. Ann Christian A. Francisco, Schools Division Coordinator for Journalism. The selection criteria for winner will follow the guidelines outlined in Regional Memorandum 244 s. 2023. Refer to Enclosure 3 for the details.




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- 10.A school Publication Contest for elementary and secondary level will also be held following the guidelines in DepEd Memorandum No. 24 s. 2023. All public and private elementary and secondary schools are required to submit their publication. All entries, spanning from June 2023 to March 2024, must be submitted in PDF format via official One drive. The deadline of submission is on February 22, 2024. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 11. School paper advisers must electronically submit their list of participants using template in Enclosure 2. This submission should be completed on or before January 25, 2024 via official One drive to be forwarded to the schoolheads' official group chatroom.
- 12. A registration fee of P150.00 and membership fee of P30.00 for each participating campus journalist will be collected to help cover expenses, including supplies, evaluators, meals, awards, and other related costs. The registration fees may be chargeable to school publication funds, school MOOE, and other local school funds in accordance with standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Meanwhile, participants from private schools are encouraged to coordinate with their respective schools to address their registration fees.
- 13.A membership fee of P60.00 will also be collected from each school paper adviser/coach. Treasurers of DASSPA and DAESPA shall facilitate the collection of membership fees, accepting payments in cash or GCASH. Payments can be made to Mr. Leoval DG. Dela Cruz at 09912307395.
- 14. School paper advisers shall ensure the payment of registration fees for their participants on or before January 26, 2024 at the cash section of the Schools Division Office. Only participants with paid registration and membership fees are eligible for the competition.
- 15. It is emphasized that NO payment shall be made during the contest proper.
- 16. School paper advisers and coaches are responsible for the safety and security of their pupils and students during the entire duration of 2024 DSPC.
- 17. Throughout the duration of the competition, the school paper advisers, coaches, and parents are NOT allowed in the contest venue.
- 18. Select school paper advisers/coaches from public and private schools shall serve as contest/room facilitators. SPAs/coaches in elementary schools shall be assigned at the secondary level and vice versa.
- 19.It is reiterated that learners joining the conference including higher-level competition in journalism shall be given the rightful, valid, and planned considerations in their academic written requirements and performances.









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- 20. Travel expenses arising from the participation of working committee chairs and members from both school and schools division office in DSPC-related activities shall be covered by the respective school or division MOOE and other local fund sources subject to standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 21. This Memorandum shall serve as the official authority to travel of the participants involved in the DSPC and other related DSPC activities.
