GUIDELINES FOR 2024 REGIONAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE

- 1. Abstract must not be more than 250 words in letter-sized papers, Bookman Font 11, and single spaced. The abstract must contain the following: title of the paper, author/s name, Schools Division Office, email address, abstract content, and keywords.
- 2. In addition, the abstract must contain the purpose of the study, research design or methodology, findings, research limitations, implications of the study, originality or value, and keywords.
- 3. The PowerPoint presentation must have a maximum of 12 slides. Using the file name format

(SDO_CategoryName_Name of Proponent/s)
(e.g. San Jose City_Teacher Category_Juan dela Cruz)

The presentation must contain the introduction, methods, results, discussion, conclusion, and recommendations.

- 4. Oral presentation using PowerPoint will be for 10 minutes only which will be followed by a five-minute question and answer.
- 5. All research papers will be presented will be evaluated by the invited panel of research experts. The order of oral presentation of the different themes for evaluation are as follows:
 - Day 1 Elementary and JHS/SHS Principal Categories
 - Day 2 Teacher and Non-Teaching/Teaching Related Categories
 - Day 3 Supervisors and Program Coordinators Categories

RESEARCH PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- 1. Each presenter's POWERPOINT PRESENTATION (in ppt or pptx format) must contain a maximum of 12 slides. It must include the following:
 - a. Introduction (Research Title, Name of Researcher/s, Rationale, Statement of the Problem)
 - b. Methods (Type of Study/Research Design, Sampling and Sampling Technique, Participants/Respondents, Instrument, and/or statistical tests or data analysis techniques)
 - c. Results and Discussion (in tabular format only)
 - d. Conclusion and Recommendations
- 2. Each presenter will be given a maximum of 10 minutes to present his/her research paper. After the presentation, a 5-minute Q & A will follow. This time, allotment will be imposed strictly.
- 3. Each presenter must have a backup file of his/her PPT in case technical glitches will be experienced during the presentation.
- 4. Presenters must be in the specified breakout session room 15 minutes before their scheduled presentations.
- 5. The distinguished panel of research evaluators will convene to evaluate the research presentations. The moderators will be responsible for facilitating the smooth transition of presentations and moderating the question and answer sessions, ensuring a seamless flow of the event.
- 6. Three outstanding papers will be carefully chosen for each theme, while one best oral presented per theme will also be selected. The awarding ceremony will take place during the closing program of the activity.
