NATIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF LEARNER RIGHTS AND PROTECTION (LRP) ON WHEELS 2024

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisor (SGOD) All Public and Private Schoolheads School Learner Rights and Protection Focal Persons All Others Concerned

- 1. In line with Regional Memorandum No. 452, s. 2024, entitled National Implementation of Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) on Wheels 2024, dated June 27, 2024, the Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), through the Learner Formation Division, announces the conduct of the National Implementation of Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) on Wheels 2024.
- 2. This activity aims to bring educational rights awareness and protection services to create a safer and more inclusive learning environment for all learners in line with DepEd's zero-tolerance policy for any act of learner abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, bullying, and other forms of abuse, and emphasizes the importances of LRP in Schools.
- Relative to this activity, all schools, both public and private, are instructed to roll-up 3. banners in the entrance of their schools or in conspicuous areas in the school. - 4. In addition, to advocate, create awareness, build knowledge, and capacitate learners to their rights in basic education, the following topics and activities are recommended during the classroom-based orientation on the opening of classes.

Topics

- 5.1 How to spot the "Red Flags" of bullying;
- 5.2 Anti-OSAEC and Anti-CSAEM: Safer Internet Practices for Learners; and, Empowering Learners to Report Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) Abuse Cases to Learners Helpline and Other Support.

- 5.4 Interactive and Panel Discussion on Child's Basic Rights
- 5.5 Art-based activities:
- 5.6 Roleplays; and,
- 5.7 Simulations
- 5. All public schools are encouraged to integrate "Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) on Wheels (tricycle or tribike) during their respective School Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off.
