CONDUCT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND PSYCHOSOCIAL SUPPORT SERVICES (MHPSS) ON THE OPENING OF CLASSES FOR SY 2024-2025

1. In reference to DRRMS Memorandum No. 07-26-24-0001 titled *Conduct of Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services (MHPSS) on the Opening of Classes for SY 2024-2025 in Schools Affected by Southwest Monsoon and Super Typhoon Carina*, this Office mandates the conduct of Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services (MHPSS) activities for all learners daily during the first hour of the first week of the opening of classes for the school year 2024-2025.
2. Schoolheads are advised to include in their class program the 1-hour daily schedule of the MHPSS as first period in the morning and to supervise the week-long implementation of it. The relevant materials for the MHPSS which include the Psychosocial Support Activity Pack (Teacher's Guide), MHPSS Evaluation Form, and other references can be found in this link <https://bit.ly/PSAP20240725>.
3. The schedule of administration of the Psychosocial Support (Pre-Evaluation), checking and interpreting learner's responses using the Teachers' Guide for Scoring and Interpretation will be on July 29, 2024, before the first facilitation of the activity, while the Post-Evaluation will be on August 5, 2024, right after the last facilitation of the activity.
4. Attached is the template of the Activity Completion Report to be accomplished by the teacher-adviser and to be submitted to their School Heads. All schools should submit a hardcopy of the consolidated results of the pre and post evaluation of the Psychosocial Support at the Records unit not later than August 16, 2024. In light of the potential impacts of Southwest Moonson and Super Typhoon Carina, which may also adversely affect the mental health of learners, the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) requires all schools in the affected regions to conduct Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services (MHPSS) activities or Psychological First Aid (PFA) for all learners during the first hour of the first week of the opening of classes for the school year 2024-2025.

The facilitator of MHPSS or PFA can use the Psychosocial Activity Pack (PSAP), which was developed by DRRMS. These materials can be accessed at this link: <https://bit.ly/PSAP20240725> or through the QR code provided below.

Moreover, to support teachers in understanding the materials, recorded videos of the learning sessions and orientation conducted last August 2022 are available in the same link. Furthermore, should teachers decide to conduct the psychosocial evaluation, the guide on its administration, interpretation, and documentation can also be accessed in the mentioned link.

All concerned Divisions are advised to mobilize all available MHPSS/PFA-trained non-teaching personnel to conduct the same activity for all teachers to support them in effectively teaching the learners and promoting their well-being.
