SCHOOLS DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 262, s. 2024

SUBMISSION OF SCHOOL CLASS PROGRAM, LIST OF TEACHERS DESIGNATED TO PERFORM TEACHING-RELATED ASSIGNMENTS AND E -SF7

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Schoolheads, Public Elementary/Integrated/ Secondary Schools All Others Concerned

- 1. In reference to DepEd Order 5, s. 2024, titled, "Rationalization of Teacher's Workload in Public Schools and Payment of Teaching Overload", this Office through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), reiterates the roles and responsibilities of schoolheads, as follows:
 - a. Exercise fair, reasonable, and equitable distribution of teaching workload and overload, teaching-related assignments, and other workload of teachers using eSF7, consistent with DepEd rules and regulations.
 - b. In cases of teaching overload, consider the specialization requirements, when assigning additional teaching loads.
 - c. Continuously provide opportunities for teachers to develop professionally.
 - d. Ensure strict compliance with the prescribed workload of teachers using eSF7.
 - e. Strengthen monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of DO 5, s. 2024.
- 2. In designating teaching-related assignments, the following provisions of DepEd Order 5, s. 2024 are hereby reiterated:
 - a. Only the following teaching-related assignments may be designated to teachers, PROVIDED, developmental programs are included in the SIP.
 - School Coordinator: Reading/Literacy/Numeracy, Research, Special Needs Education (SNED), ICT, Guidance and Advocacy, Inclusive Education
 - Trainer/Adviser: School Paper, Sports Development Program, SELG/SSLG
 - Chairmanship: Grade Level and Learning Area
 - b. Schoolheads shall consider the specialization of teachers who shall be assigned, along with their respective workloads. Teachers with less than six (6) hours of teaching load shall be prioritized in the designation of teaching-related assignments.

- c. School shall prepare a list of teachers designated to perform teachingrelated assignments and submit the same to the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent for approval.
- 3. In the preparation of the e-SF7, school heads are reminded of the following:
 - a. DepEd Memorandum 52, s. 2023, titled, Adoption of the DepEd Electronic School Form 7 (eSF7), stipulates that the accomplishment of eSF7 is the primary responsibility and accountability of the school heads.
