REITERATION OF WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE IN SCHOOLS (WINS) PROGRAM

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Education Program Supervisors Public Elementary and Secondary Heads All Others Concerned

- Pursuant to Deped Order No. 10, s. 2016 entitled Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in Schools, this office hereby directed all Public Elementary and Secondary Schools to strictly adhere with the policy and guidelines and implement activities relative to the program.
- 2. The objective of this program is to promote correct hygiene and sanitation practices among school children and provide a clean and safe environment in and around schools to keep all learners and personnel safe and healthy. Activities such as daily group handwashing and toothbrushing activities shall be observed in all grade levels, ensure availability of safe drinking water, proper solid waste management, proper drainage and the elimination of breeding grounds for mosquitoes to prevent vector- borne diseases such as Dengue Virus and food sanitation in school canteens.
- 3. In line with this, all public schools are hereby instructed to regularly update the WinS Online Monitoring System on Learners' Information System to monitor their progress to the WinS Three Star Rating System and collaborate with key partners and stakeholders for the successful implementation of the program.
