# REGION-WIDE ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECT ALL NUMERATES (PAN) ASSESSMENT FOR GRADES 4 TO 7 LEARNERS

To

Schools Division Superintendents

Curriculum Implementation Division Chiefs

Division Education Program Supervisors in Mathematics

- 1. Project All Numerates (PAN) is undertaken every school year in all public schools in Region III to monitor numeracy skills acquired by all learners on their previous grade level and develop instructional strategies and intervention approaches to develop and improve learners' level of numeracy.
- 2. This project aspires to improve the numeracy skills of learners and improve learning outcomes in Mathematics with the aid of intervention programs and best practices that highly promote sustainable quality instruction of the DepEd Curriculum.
- 3. In view of this, the Department of Education Regional Office 3 (DepEd-RO 3), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the region-wide administration of Project All Numerates (PAN) assessment for Grades 4 to 7, to wit:

Activity	Testing Window
Pre-Assessment	September 2 to 6, 2024
Mid-Year Assessment	December 2 to 6, 2024
Post Assessment	March 3 to 7, 2025

4. The project is aimed at:

- determining the numeracy level of Grades 4 to 7 learners as the basis for the interventions and innovations at the school and division level targeting the needs of the learners;
- Identifying the different consolidated issues, concerns, challenges, and best practices of each Division as a basis for plans and ways forward;
- utilizing the results as a significant basis for planning suitable and appropriate context-based intervention strategies for the next school year; and







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- d. providing salient findings, conclusions, and recommendations in revisiting current instructional practices of teachers in assisting learners towards improving their levels of numeracy.
- 5. Schools Division Offices, particularly the Division Learning Resource Management and Development Section (LRMDS) Supervisors, shall be provided with the Google Drive link containing the files of the assessment tools in all learning areas through the Regional Learning Resource Supervisor. The assessment tools shall be downloaded by the division LRMDS supervisors and uploaded to the newly created Google Drive and then shared to school heads/school testing coordinators.
- 6. The Regional and Division Education Program Supervisors (EPS) in Mathematics shall conduct the monitoring of the administration of the pre-assessment, mid-year assessment, and post-assessment on the aforementioned dates.
- 7. All schools shall ensure the veracity and security of the assessment tools and shall be administered properly. The school heads shall strictly supervise the conduct of the assessment.
- 8. All consolidated reports from the schools shall be submitted to the schools division for proper consolidation by the division EPS in Mathematics. Likewise, division consolidated summary reports on the conduct of the PAN assessment shall be submitted to the regional office on the following dates:

Pre-Assessment	September 27, 2024
Mid-Year Assessment	December 20, 2024
Post Assessment	March 28, 2025

- 9. All reports should be properly endorsed to the regional office in PDF file along with the MS Word file. The regional EPS in Mathematics will provide the link for the uploading of those files.
- 10. Also, the division EPS in Mathematics will receive a separate Microsoft 365 Excel file to put the consolidated PAN assessment results. This file will contain the percentage of non-numerates, nearly-numerates, and numerates, as well as the five (5) least mastered and five (5) most mastered competencies/skills from grades 4 to 7.
- 11. The school may utilize print or non-print materials in the administration of the PAN assessments. Other modalities using computer-based or computer-assisted approaches may be adapted by the schools.







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- The printing and/or reproduction of the assessment tools shall be charged to the School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and other local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules.
- Teacher-examiners may click the link of the explainer video to watch the procedures on how to administer the PAN tools in assessing learners' numeracy skills (https://tinyurl.com/PANExplainerVideo).
- All EPS in Mathematics are requested to orient all mathematics coordinators and/or mathematics teachers/elementary teachers from grades 4 through 7 on the use and procedures of conducting the PAN assessment.
- 15. Associated with PAN is the Rapid Math Assessment (RMA) for Grades 1 to 3 which focuses on evaluating learners' foundational mathematical skills and understanding in a concise and efficient manner.
- In addition, starting school year (SY) 2024-2025, Only Grades 4 to 7 will take the PAN Assessment Tools. Grades 1 to 3 will take the RMA and will continue to use the Window Cards provided by PAN as part of their Drill. A separate memorandum for RMA will be released.
