
2024 OBSERVANCE OF THE 18-DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN (VAW)

- With reference to the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) Memorandum Circular No. 2024-04 Guide for the 2024 Observance of the 18-day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW), the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) spearheads the 18-day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW) from November 25 to December 12, 2024.
- The 2024 18-day Campaign to End VAW will center the recurring six-year (2022-2027) theme, "UniTEd for a VAW-free Philippines," which is still aligned with the "UniTE by 2030 to END VAW" initiative of the UN and with its sub-theme, "VAW Bigyang-Wakas, Ngayon na ang Oras!"
- To promote awareness about this campaign, Offices and schools are encouraged to participate in the following activities:
 - a: VAW Awareness in Flag Ceremonies. Offices and schools are encouraged to include VAW-related presentations, campaign materials, and the "All Women Cast Lupang Hinirang" video in flag ceremonies during the campaign period to raise awareness and encourage active participation. The "All Women Cast Lupang Hinirang" video can be downloaded from bit.ly/AllWomenAnthem. Using the "18-day campaign to End VAW Prayer" is also encouraged.
 - b. Display of VAW Campaign Banners. Campaign banners should be printed and displayed at the conspicuous places in offices and schools. To know about the design, specifications, and guidelines on the use of banner, visit bit/lu/vawfreeph2024.
 - c. Online Advocacy for a VAW-Free Philippines. Participation in online advocacv under the hashtags #VAWfreePH, #VowToEndVAW, #FilipinoMarespeto #SafeSpacesKasaliTayo, and other campaign-related hashtags is encouraged. Online support may be demonstrated by:
 - Uploading the official campaign logo, banner, advocacy videos, and other materials on websites and social media accounts;
 - Sharing of VAW-related materials, news, articles, photos, and other relevant information online; and
 - Using the 18-day Campaign to End VAW Facebook Profile Frame. which is available on the PCW Facebook page or on the GAD Region III Facebook page.



- d. Installation of the "The Orange Exhibit: Journey towards a VAW-free Philippines". Offices and schools are encouraged to install the "The Orange Exhibit: Journey towards a VAW-free Philippines" during the campaign period (design can be downloaded from bit.ly/orangeexhibit). Own version of the "Orange Exhibit" may also be developed to chronicle achievements in the fight against VAW.
- e. Educational Sessions on VAW and Related Laws. VAW-related activities such as discussions, orientations, and educational sessions on VAW, anti-VAW legislation and available support services, should be conducted during the campaign period to inform and educate education leaders, teachers, students and staff.
- f. Symbolic Wearing of Orange. Education leaders, teachers, students and staff are encouraged to wear orange on the first day of the Campaign and on Fridays of the campaign period, as a solidarity with the 18-day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW).
